## Notes

- All figures represent total cash compensation (base + variable) for the United Kingdom professional services sector.
- Level 5 sample size was suppressed by the survey provider due to a confidentiality threshold (fewer than 15 respondents in this cut). The P25/P50/P75 figures are carried forward from the Q4 2024 edition.
- The survey covers "advisory and consulting firms with 250–2,000 UK-based employees." Northbridge Advisory Partners falls within this band.
- Geographic adjustment: London weighting is included in the base figures for firms with a London headquarters. Northbridge's regional offices may need a separate adjustment, but the applicable regional discount factor was not included in this extract.
- Variable compensation ranges vary significantly by practice area. The figures above assume a blended variable rate. For practices with above-average variable structures (e.g., transaction advisory), the P75 may understate total compensation.
